 Coldest temp ever recorded in Colorado

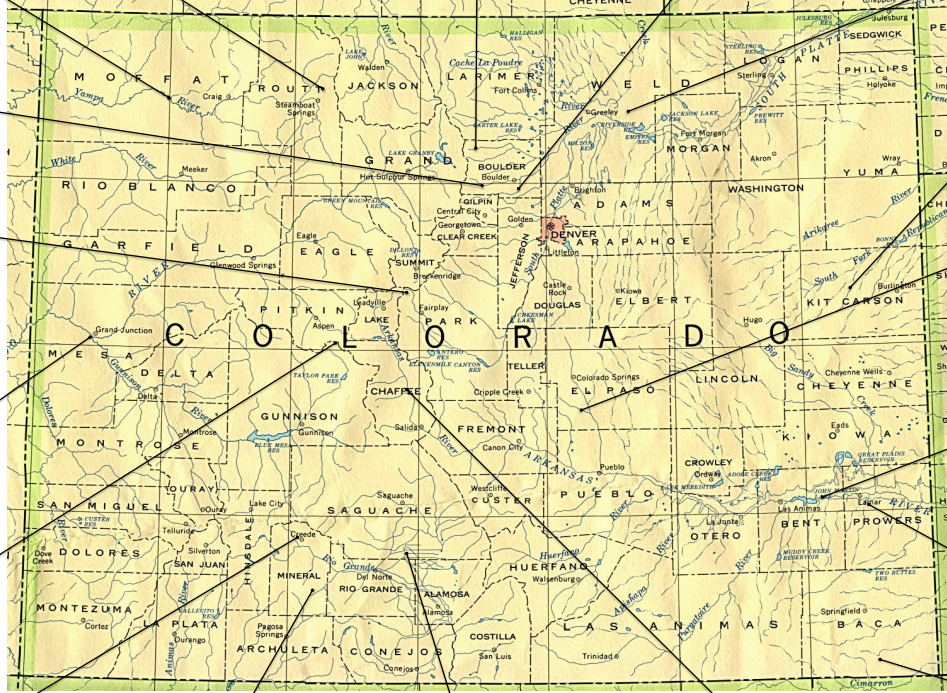
Buffalo Pass
